# Reports

Payee routines – where amounts are paid to the member

Where medical outlay is greater than Hospital outlay

Where services are outside normal profile

By item number

Total

By fortnight, month, quarter, etc

>3 retail lodgements

# Reports - cont

Non-Residents:

On-line claims:

High claimers

Daily (rolling 7 days cycle)

Fortnightly

Monthly

Process – “flag” membership/Provider

# Reports cont

Reverse bank accounts

IP address

Other detail:

Name, Address, Post code, email etc.

# Reports cont

Top 500 memberships:

All benefit outlays (relationship to Medicare, Hospital etc.)

By daily, monthly, YTD

Top 50 Medical benefits only

By daily, weekly, MTD, YTD, trend /week

# Providers

- Similarity to other provider in structure, claiming profile
  - Apply logic/rules of specialty vs item numbers
  - Trend outside the norm +/-
  - Mapping activity – drawing profile
  - Clinical decision points:
    - item 15600 (oncolgy)
    - Item 16500 (antenatal attendance), 16522 (management of labour)

# Hospitals

- Upcoding
- 7 day readmits
- Outside of contract – add ons
- IFC
- ICU
- Long stayers
- Appropriate care, price, location
