Private Health Insurance (Prostheses) Rules (No. 2) 2019

The delegate of the Minister for Health has made the *Private Health Insurance (Prostheses) Rules (No. 2) 2019* (the Rules) to repeal and replace the *Private Health Insurance (Prostheses) Rules (No. 1) 2019*.

Schedule 1 to the Rules is commonly known as the Prostheses List.

The Rules have been registered on the Federal Register of Legislation and come into effect on 1 July 2019.
