The NJRR is administered by Australian Orthopaedic Association (AOA), and is funded under the Commonwealth grant agreement. The funds for the agreement are fully cost-recovered from the sponsors of the joint replacement prostheses listed on the Prostheses List, by collecting the NJRR levies on an annual basis.

The Department has issued invoices for these levies to the relevant sponsors.
