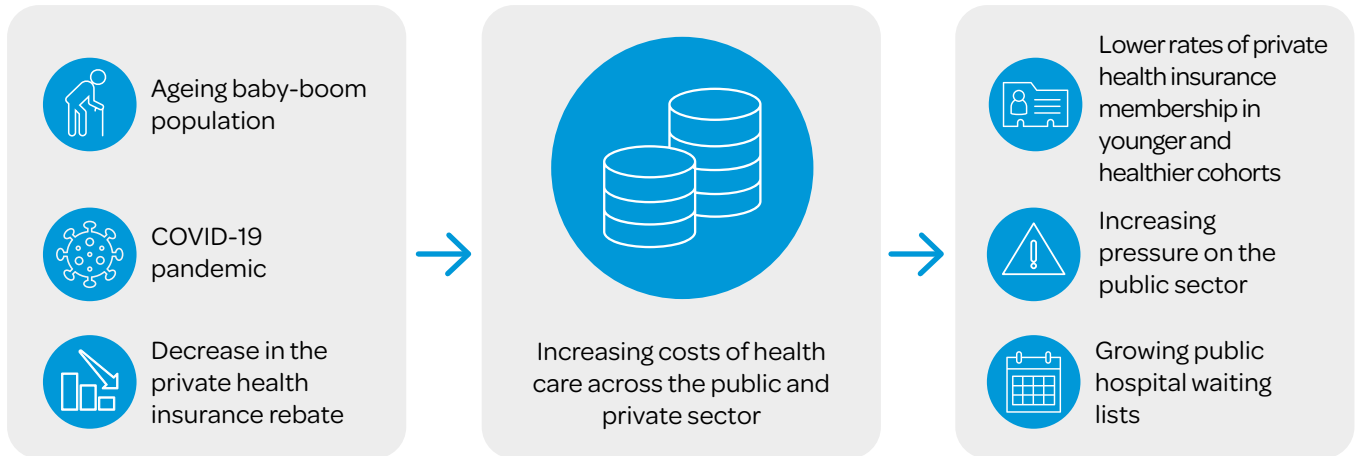


Reducing pressure on families and hospitals
